**Say:** Today, in big worship, our pastor blessed this bread and this juice for Holy Communion. Holy -- means something where God is present and communion is when people come together with God and each other.

The bread and the juice remind us of Jesus who shared bread and juice with his friends and told them to always share it with one another. He said that the bread represents his body that was broken for you and the juice represents his blood that was shed for you when he died on the cross. So we do Communion to remember that Jesus loves us and is our best friend and also because he told us too!

So, as we share this bread and this juice, it's like we are one big group of Jesus' friends -- grown ups, children and teens, who remember that we are being obedient to Jesus and this is a Holy time when we remember how much God loves us and how he offers us grace. Grace is receiving something that we don't deserve. God loved us so much that he sent Jesus to die on the cross for us and continues to show us love and grace even when we disobey Him.
