- When you open a presentation make sure to “Enable Content”. (A second warning may pop up.)
- To start a presentation click the “Slide Show” button or go to the Slide Show menu.
- Pencil means there is a worksheet.
- Open book means there are teacher notes at the bottom.
- If there is a red F that means it is an interactive page. The backwards arrow restarts the interaction. In some cases it adds different content.
- You can make changes to any of the content except the interactive slides.
- Make sure to go to “Save as” and save it to where you want it to go.
