

## **My BrainPOP**

My BrainPOP allows a teacher to set up a class in BrainPOP. With My BrainPOP a teacher can give students assignments and collect student data, like quiz grades.

### **Teacher Set Up**

1. Go to brainpop.com
2. Click at the top where it says “Enter Code
3. Type our Educator Code: *This is a code that is different for each building.*
4. Create your account. When you create your account you will create the code that your students will use to log in.
5. Have the students use the information below to create their own accounts.

### **Student Directions**

1. Go to Brainpop.com
2. Click “Enter Code”
3. Type \_\_\_\_\_ (this is a code you create)
4. You need to create a username so in the boxes below where you sign in click “Sign Up Now”
5. Fill in every box. For username and password use your Moby Max information. You have to type your password 2 times.
6. Pick a security question that has an answer you know how to spell and type that answer.
7. Pick one of the pictures that you will remember later.
8. Click Create Account.
9. Click Sign-in
10. From now on all you have to do is use your username and password to log in.


Designed for K-3. Each video has a 5 question easy quiz and a 5 question hard quiz.

## Getting Started

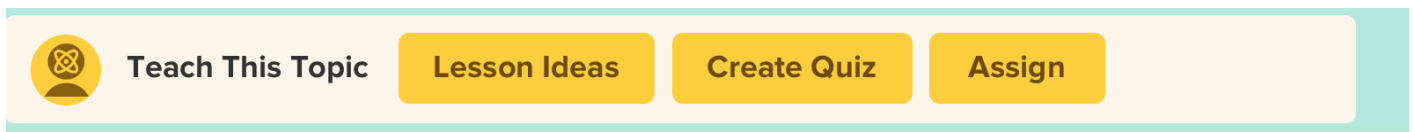

## Assigning Videos and Quizzes

Once you have students in your class you can give them assignments. Pick a video you want to use and at the bottom of that page you will see 3 options.



You can get more lesson ideas or create your own quiz that can be assigned to the students. If you want to assign the video to your class click assign. If you know you want to add more than just the video use the Assignment Builder. This is found at the bottom of the page AFTER you click assign. Here you can make a list of activities you want your students to complete.

If you do not assign an activity, students will have to click “Submit to Teacher” when they are done.

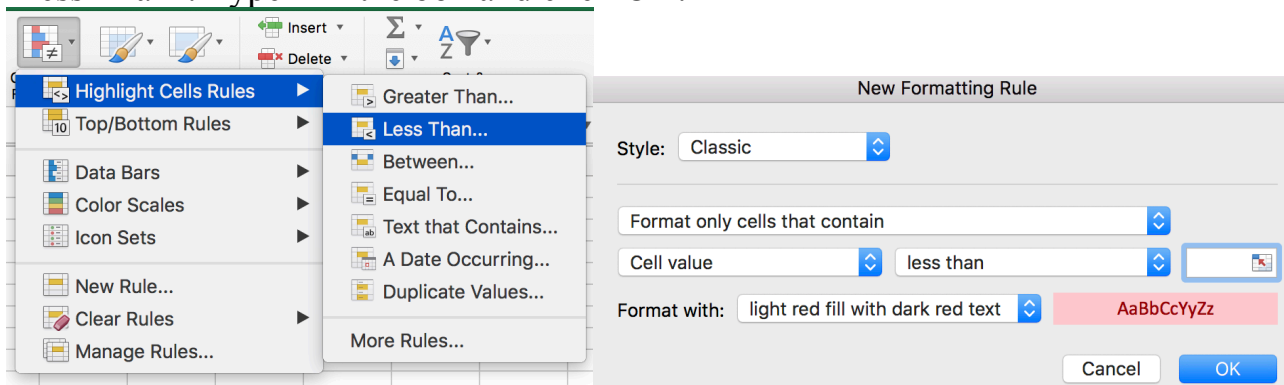
## Viewing Student's Grades

To see the results of an assignment click on “My Classes” at top left. From here you can see a Timeline or Spreadsheet view of the class. On the Spreadsheet you can see:



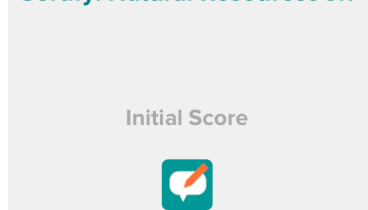
Viewing the results can be hard to see on this screen, so click  **Export (CSV)** and BrainPOP will download all of the results to Excel.

If you want to quickly find the students who earned a certain score, Excel has a feature called “Conditional Formatting”. Highlight the scores and click the “Conditional Formatting” button. If you want to find everyone who score less than 4, chose “Highlight Cell Rules” - “Less Than”. Type 4 in the box and click OK.



From the Spreadsheet screen you can also see the results of the activities like Sortify. Click the speech Bubble to see the student's response.
